The entire hotel was lovingly refurbished in 2011 to the highest standard and in 2012 opened a state of the art Health Club, with indoor swimming pool, relaxing spa and steam room. The hotel has a tennis court and the renowned Le Moye golf course nearby.

**Facilities:** **Restaurant:** We will dine in the Bay Restaurant, an oak panelled dining room overlooking the beautiful bay of St Brelade's, which compliments the high standard of cuisine and service. Long standing Head Chef, Franz Hacker, always makes use of the plentiful local supply of fresh seafood and vegetables

**Bar/Lounge:** The Cocktail Bar is a cosy and informal room with a terrace overlooking the Bay, in which to chat, read or have a light lunch from the 'Lite Bites' menu, afternoon tea or indeed cocktails.

**Spa:** With the hustle and bustle of daily life it is important to find time to relax and unwind. The Spa is situated within the hotel and offers a range of treatments such as beauty, facials, body treatments and massages to help rejuvenate mind, body and soul. There is also a hair salon and nail bar. It is advisable to pre-book treatments directly, on 01534 746141, to avoid disappointment.

**Leisure:** Facilities include a heated indoor swimming pool, outdoor pool, spa pool, steam room, gymnasium and an outdoor all-weather tennis court.



**Rooms:** All rooms are non-smoking and are tastefully appointed and capture the essence of the 19<sup>th</sup> Century hotel. Rooms either overlook the 5 acres of delightful gardens or offer superb sea views.

Every room has satellite television, broadband internet access, direct dial telephones, hair dryer and complimentary fresh fruit bowl on the first night. 24 hour room service is offered.

**Garden View Room:** Well-appointed, comfortable en-suite rooms with either twin or double beds. These rooms overlook the hotels delightful gardens and do not have a sea view.

**Sea View Room:** These rooms afford all the comforts of the Garden rooms with the added bonus of a balcony overlooking St Brelade's Bay.

**Superior Room:** These rooms afford all the comforts of the Garden rooms with Sea Views across St Brelade's Bay. These rooms are slightly larger than the Sea View rooms and also have an in-room safe, tea/coffee making facilities, walk-in shower with separate bath, bathrobes and Hildon Water. Please note that there are only 3 x Superior rooms in the hotel and they all have balconies.



**Bridge Room:** ARBH has exclusive use of the newly refurbished Rosiere Suite. The room has plenty of natural light and a private terrace overlooking the Bay. It has an area for refreshments, private bar area and toilet facilities.



**Jersey:** Jersey is the most southerly point in the British Isles and has a unique climate as it is only fourteen miles from France and warmed by the Gulf stream. Jersey has been an island for approximately 8,000 years and at its extremes it measures just 10 miles east to west and six miles north to south.

Jersey possesses a fascinating and complex history stretching back over a thousand years. Its very landscape - Norman style farmhouses, narrow winding lanes, small fields and French street names - reflects its entwinement with the fates of two great nations: Britain and France.

**FLIGHTS and Transfers:**

You will need to book your own flights which is easily done online or with your travel agent. BA and EasyJet fly from Gatwick and many other airports. The hotel is only a 10 minute drive from the airport where taxis are readily available.

**Bookings:** £150 per person non-refundable deposit is required on booking, and the full balance for the holiday is payable eight weeks beforehand. All bookings will be treated on a "first come first served" basis.

**Cancellation:** Once the balance has been paid, it is non-refundable but you can claim on your insurance.

**Travel:**      **By air:**      You will need to book your own flights. If you choose to fly with BA from Gatwick then we recommend the following approx. flight times: 12.00 - 13.05 outbound on the Tuesday and 17.35 - 18.35 inbound on Friday. The hotel is only a 10 minute drive from the airport where taxis are readily available.

**By sea:**      If you wish to bring your car to the Jersey, fast ferry services leave from the south coast of England. Sail from Poole or Weymouth with Condor Ferries and you can be in Jersey in less than 4 hours

**Passport/Visa:** British citizens and citizens of the Irish Republic do not require passports or visas to visit Jersey. Other EU citizens require only their ID cards for entry. Citizens from non-EU countries will need a passport and should check before travelling whether a visa is required.

**Extra nights:** You are welcome to stay for extra nights at the hotel. Please contact the hotel directly to book in any extra nights which are to be settled directly with the hotel. ARBH accept no responsibility for the booking, cancellation or payment of extra nights.
