2025 Ski Bridge Holiday



4 Superior Alpin Juwel Hotel* *Saturday 8 – 15 March 2025*

After the great success of last year, we are delighted to return to the luxurious 4* Superior Hotel Alpin Juwel in the town of Hinterglemm, Austria which is 90 minutes transfer time from Salzburg airport. The hotel is just a two minutes' walk away from the nearest ski lifts. On this link read an article that says Saalbach has the second best snow record in Europe

Home to arguably the world's best ski lift system Saalbach Hinterglemm has links to Fieberbrunn and Leogang and forms one of Austria's largest ski areas with 270km of pistes and over 70 lifts with the highest peak over 2000m.

The hotel is 700 metres from the centre of Hinterglemm and has excellent cuisine, spacious bridge room and superb spa facilities which include indoor and outdoor swimming pools. We have also secured some cheaper accommodation at the nearby 3* Hotel Gamshag, located just a three-minute walk from Hotel Alpin Juwel.

Jack Stocken (with co-host Grazyna Wrobel) will be hosting an informative and entertaining Bridge programme and, as ever, the bridge standard is friendly Intermediate and no partner necessary. Jack will be running all other aspects of the holiday including bookings. Please book early.

We have a wonderful team of ski leaders headed by Suzi McArthur and Paul Ubysz. The ski leaders are all current or ex Ski Club of Great Britain reps and bring all their charm and expertise to the slopes. We will aim to keep the ski group size to a maximum of eight (or nine). **To join our ski leaders, skiers need to be able to ski red runs competently in any conditions.**

Resort: Hinterglemm is a mainly traffic free resort town set in picturesque alpine mountain area in the Saalbach valley which is orientated east west with ski slopes either side of the river Saalach. The hotel provides easy access to the nearest ski slope being about a 2-minute walk. The slightly larger resort town of Saalbach is situated about 2km downstream from Hinterglemm and is also largely traffic free. Regular ski buses run between Saalbach and Hinterglemm to service the ski lifts on both sides of the valley and there is fairly frequent bus service to the larger town of Zell am See.



Skiing: A four resort network of ski pistes and modern lifts links Hinterglemm to Saalbach, Fieberbrunn and Leogang giving access to 270km of pistes up to an altitude of 2044m with varying degrees of difficulty. The area is very scenic with many tree lined runs and has a good snow record.

The area affords extensive off-piste skiing for the suitably equipped and experienced skier looking for adventure.

The runs on the north side of the valley (south facing slopes) tend to be preferred in sunny weather. The pistes on the south side of the valley (north facing slopes) are more shaded and thus have better snow cover, particularly late in the season.

The ski lift pass covers the ski buses and lift systems needed to access the nearby resorts of Zell am See and the Kaprun glacier resort thus giving access to an extended ski terrain of a further 140km up to over 3000m altitude. The combined area is so vast that it is virtually impossible to ski all areas fully in a single week.

What's more, you can set out from nearest ski lift a short walk from the hotel, have a great day out exploring the vast area and return via the ski pistes to finish close to the hotel at the end of a great day's skiing.



There is also plenty to do for non-skiers: cross country skiing and snowshoeing to take in the beautiful scenery, dogsledding, tobogganing and ice-skating to name but a few. Please note that non-skiers get a £75 discount off the price. There is no discount for non-bridge players!

Ski Leaders: We are delighted to have the services of our team of ski hosts to cater for different ski standards and larger numbers, as this service has been so popular in recent years. Hosted by Suzi McArthur and Paul Ubysz, the team have kindly agreed to ski guide for the week on a voluntary basis. There will be a number of groups, catering for different standards. We will aim to keep the ski group size to a maximum of eight (or nine) guests.

To join our ski leaders, **skiers need to be able to ski red runs competently in any conditions**; our ski leaders reserve the right to swap people between groups and if necessary, tell a skier that they must make their own arrangements with ski school at their own expense.

Bridge: The Bridge will start from 5.30pm onwards. The Bridge programme will follow its regular format, namely a pre-dinner tuition session with Andrew Robson's set hands, 5.30pm – 7pm (every night apart from Wednesday), and after dinner, Gentle Duplicate, 8.45pm – 10.45pm, aimed at the friendly Intermediate player. Supervised Bridge will be offered after dinner as an alternative to Duplicate (minimum numbers apply). The Bridge is not suitable for players that are used to a serious 24 board club duplicate. Hotel: The modernised lifestyle hotel Alpin Juwel boasts a unique panorama location – directly on the ski slopes and in the heart of beautiful hiking country, modern and traditional architecture using only natural materials, panorama infinity pool, breakfast until noon, an individual wellness concept with local products, drive-in/check-in in the underground parking garage, the Alpinveda Spa with therapists from Sri Lanka, an 800 sqm sun bathing meadow, a 200 sqm roof terrace, three unique restaurants and much more. Two lifts also run directly to the centre of Hintertglen. "Exclusive, individual, different" is the hotel's motto, and can be seen everywhere you look. Alpin Juwel promises exclusive living, healthy Austrian cooking, a cosy atmosphere and a unique sleeping experience in an ideal location with a view of the entire valley all year round. Wellness: Beside the indoor and outdoor pools you will find a sauna area, beauty and spa treatments as well as Ayurveda massages. You also can take part in the daily Yoga training which will upload your batteries for the rest of the day.



Breakfast is in the Ellmau Stube restaurant between 0700 and 1030. There is a daily breakfast buffet and a snack buffet available from 2.30pm – 4.30pm daily. There will be a welcome drink for our group on the first evening in the bar.

Please ensure that all luggage is clearly labelled so that porters can deliver them directly to the bedrooms.

Bedrooms: All rooms are non-smoking with minibar, safe, telephone, bathrobe, alarm clock, wireless from 7am to 11pm, balcony with chairs. As always, all rooms will be allocated on a “First come, first served basis” and rooming allocations are ultimately made at the hotel’s discretion. Please note that twin bedded rooms are “Austrian doubles” but the hotel can make up separate beds. Please specify on your booking form if you would prefer a bath or shower.

Kristall Double: 20 - 25 m2 Living room, some with light therapy, exclusive bathroom (with bath, shower, toilet, partly double sink, magnifying mirror, hair dryer, some music), cable TV

Rubin Double: 30 - 35 m2 Living room with Samina pine beds, partly panoramic loggia, partly Grander water fountains, exclusive bathroom (shower, cosmetic mirror, hairdryer, music), cupboard, radio, digital TV. These rooms are more expensive as they are more modern than Kristalls.

Junior Suite Rubin: 38 m2 Living room with Samina pine beds, panoramic loggia, Grandewasser fountain, exclusive bathroom (bathtub with panoramic window, shower, cosmetic mirror, hair dryer, double sink, music), separate WC, cupboard, radio, digital TV

Money:

Everyone must have adequate travel insurance, to **include winter sports** if necessary. On booking, a signature will be required to guarantee that you have, or will have, made the necessary arrangements to insure your party as necessary.

Lift Pass:

In 2023 the six-day pass cost EUR 338 (£300). This price is subject to a rise in 2024 and also subject to change depending on the exchange rate and the new rates for 2024.

Ski Hire:

We shall be using Intersport Breitfuss for which there is a discount for our group.

Cancellation:

The deposit is non-refundable and a cancellation charge may be made to cover any costs incurred. Once the balance has been paid, no refunds can be given but you can claim on your insurance.
