Facilities: **Restaurant:** The hotel offers the critically acclaimed The Point restaurant which has two AA red Rosettes for the nineteenth year in succession. With a seasonal menu that reflects the finest local produce accompanied by wines from a discerning and far-reaching cellar, served in the most breathtaking of locations, this water's edge restaurant offers a truly unique experience.

Bar/Lounge: The Pavilion Bar and Lounge offers a unique location enabling you to sit, relax and watch the comings and goings of marine life in Poole harbour. Whilst the Marconi Lounge, named after the Italian radio pioneer who carried out his early experiments on the site, is a cosy and informal room in which to chat, read or have a quiet drink.



Spa: With the hustle and bustle of daily life it is important to find time to relax and unwind. The Spa offers a range of treatments such as beauty, Guinot facials, complementary treatments and massages to help rejuvenate mind, body and soul. It is advisable to pre-book treatments to avoid disappointment.

Leisure: Facilities include a heated indoor swimming pool, outdoor pool, hot tub, sauna and steam rooms, gymnasium, aerobics studio and all-weather tennis court.



Rooms: All rooms are non-smoking and are furnished with special care and attention to detail. The majority have balconies and sea or harbour views across to the Purbeck Hills, Studland Beach or Brownsea Island.

Every room has SMART television, WIFI, direct dial telephones, hair dryer, courtesy tea/coffee tray and bottled water.

Inland Room: Well-appointed, comfortable en-suite rooms with either single, twin or double beds. These rooms do not have harbour or sea views.

Harbour View: These rooms afford all the comforts of the Inland rooms with the added bonus of a balcony overlooking Poole Harbour.

Sea View Room: These rooms afford all the comforts of our Inland rooms with Sea Views across to the Purbeck. Some rooms have balconies.

Deluxe Room: Sea View Double Deluxe rooms afford all the comforts of our Sea view rooms with the additional benefit of a private panoramic balcony looking out to sea. These rooms are light and airy featuring dual aspect floor to ceiling windows.



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Bridge Room:

ARBH has exclusive use of The Purbeck Suite for our Bridge sessions. The Purbeck is a light and airy room overlooking the water and chain ferry. It has an area for refreshments, private bar area and lounge for relaxing between Bridge sessions.



Poole:

Poole is positioned on a very popular stretch of coastline, with the resort of Bournemouth to the east, Studland to the south and the Jurassic coast southwest. The town has grown rapidly, and Sandbanks, a small sand spit across part of the harbour mouth, is so popular that it has the fourth highest land value, by area, in the world.

Poole Harbour:

Poole Harbour is the second largest natural harbour in the world, after Sydney, and has been a working port for many hundreds of years. The port can no longer take the largest ships due to the shallow water but is home to Sunseeker, manufacturers of luxury yachts and the departure point for ferries to France. The harbour is noted for its ecology, supporting varied habitats as well as the Brownsea Island nature reserve. The quayside and harbour was the place from which some ships departed for the D-Day landings of World War Two.

Cancellation: Once the balance has been paid, it is non-refundable.

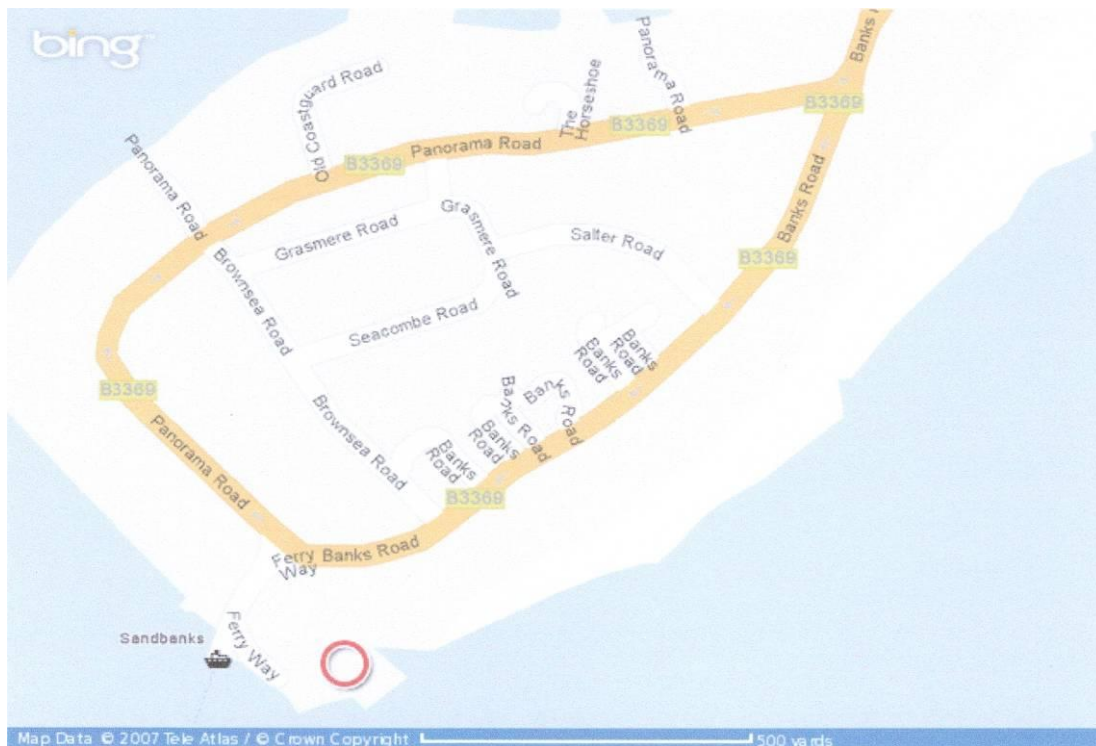
Travel: **By car:** The Haven Hotel is about a two hour drive from London and is the perfect way to travel if you want to stay on for a few extra days to explore the delights of Dorset. Please see the directions and local map below.

By train: From London, take the train from Waterloo to Parkstone (Dorset). This takes under two hours and is a direct service. A good train to get is the 13.35 from Waterloo to Parkstone (Dorset), arriving 15.32 and you can take a 10 minute taxi ride to the hotel. Travel costs are not included in the price and travel is not organised by ARBH.

Directions to the Haven Hotel, Sandbanks, Poole BH13 7QL

From London: Either take the M4 and M25 or take the A3 and M25, onto the M3. Continue onto the M27, then the A31 and finally the A338. At the roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto **Wessex Way** and continue on this road until you come to another roundabout and take the 2nd exit onto **The Avenue** (B3065). Continue until another roundabout where you take the first exit onto **Haven Road** (B3065) and then turn left onto **Shore Road** (B3369). After 0.1 mile, bear right onto **Banks Road** (B3369) and then after 0.7 miles, at the roundabout, take the first exit, continuing on **Banks Road** (B3369). After half a mile, turn left onto **Ferry Way** and you will see the **Sandbanks Hotel** after 0.1 mile. Journey time approximately two hours by car.

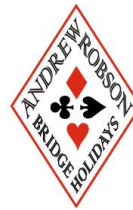
