ARBH are delighted to visit Cyprus for the first time for our summer bridge holiday: Cyprus is renowned since ancient times for its mineral wealth, superb wines and produce, and natural beauty. A "golden-green leaf thrown into the Sea" and a land of "wild weather and volcanoes," in the words of the Greek Cypriot poet Leonidas Malenis,

We will stay at the luxurious 5* Hotel Annabelle, Under the soulful care of the Michaelides family since 1985, Annabelle shines as the grand dame of 5-star hotels in Paphos. Annabelle epitomises the warmth of Cyprus, the beauty of its nature, and its hands-on culture of care and conscientiousness.

As always, there will be two interesting excursions: the first cruising from Limassol old port around this historic island and the second excursion visiting the traditional village of Omodos where we will watch a pastry demonstration, visit a Monastery and enjoy wine tasting!

<u>Programme</u>: Jack Stocken will be hosting an informative and entertaining Bridge programme which will include Andrew Robson's Lessons on four mornings (with set hands), Gentle Duplicate before dinner and relaxed supervised play after dinner. The standard is friendly improver/intermediate; the Bridge is not suitable for players that are used to a serious 24 board club duplicate.

<u>Cyprus</u>: Cyprus comprises tall mountains, fertile valleys, and wide beaches. Settled for more than 10 millennia, Cyprus stands at a cultural, linguistic, and historic crossroads between Europe and Asia. Its chief cities—the capital of Nicosia, Limassol, Famagusta, and Paphos—have absorbed the influences of generations of conquerors, pilgrims, and travellers and have an air that is both cosmopolitan and provincial.

Today Cyprus is a popular tourist destination for visitors from Europe, favoured by honeymooners (as befits the legendary home of Aphrodite, the ancient Greek goddess of love), bird-watchers drawn by the island's diversity of migratory species, and other vacationers.





<u>5* Hotel Annabelle</u>: Nestled among six acres of tropical gardens just a short stroll from Paphos harbour, centrally located Annabelle is perfect for exploring or a relaxing week by the pool. Need sand between your toes? A 10-minute walk takes you to Antasia Beach Club, our sister venue located on arguably the best beach in Paphos. The promenade and port is within an easy stroll, while Paphos airport (PFO) is just 20 minutes' away by car. The average temperature for September is 26C. <u>Leisure facilities</u>: the hotel has a complex of swimming pools, indoor pool, sauna and gym. There is a wellness centre and spa which offers a variety of facial, beauty and body treatments, yoga, massages and therapies. It is advised to pre-book these treatments to avoid disappointment.

<u>Golf:</u> There are four 18-hole golf courses close to the hotel. I will be on for a round or two so bring your golf shoes if you would like to join me!

<u>Tennis:</u> the hotel has a tennis court so I will organise some casual, fun tennis and find you a partner for some doubles





Bedrooms:

Rooms are equipped with balconies, walk-in showers, air conditioning, television, minibar, safe, coffee/tea set, bathrobe, slippers and Wi-Fi.

Inland:

Ease into languid elegance with generous entry level rooms complete with artisan furniture, cooling marble floors and classical marble bathroom. Relax on your balcony with views towards the historic Paphos or Annabelle's lush grounds. There are only a few of these available so for single occupancy only.

Cruise from Limassol Old Port

From the port, you will step aboard a catamaran boat for a four-hour coastal cruise along the beautiful shores of Limassol. This leisurely journey is all about enjoying the gentle sea breeze, calm waters, and panoramic views, perfect for unwinding. Depending on the day's wind conditions, the cruise will either glide along the Limassol city skyline or head towards the clear waters of Lady's Mile and Akrotiri. Both routes offer lovely scenery and excellent swimming opportunities.

A delicious buffet lunch of Mediterranean cuisine will be served onboard accompanied by an open bar with local drinks. Upon return to Limassol there will be some free time to enjoy a gentle stroll around the harbour and castle area. Guests can either relax with a coffee at a local café while soaking up the charm of the old town or browse the boutique shops and souvenir stores before setting off for the hotel in Paphos.





Discovering the Charm of Omodos Village

We'll set off towards Omodos Village, a charming gem nestled next to the stunning Troodos Mountain range. As we drive for about an hour, enjoy the scenic countryside, dotted with picturesque vineyards and traditional villages that reflect the heart of Cyprus.

We visit a local bakery in the village and under the guidance of a local baker, guests will enjoy a Pastry Demonstration showcasing the famous Arkatena bread, a beloved Cypriot specialty. Then discover the secrets of making "shoushoukos," a traditional sweet made from grape must and nuts. Visit the Monastery of Stavros or 'Holy Cross' where the serene atmosphere and ancient architecture offer a glimpse into the spiritual heritage of the region and then wine tasting.

Following lunch at a local tavern and time permitting; guests can wander the village's charming streets at leisure, filled with shops offering handmade lace, artisanal crafts, and local delights.

Price to be confirmed in June 2026. Delicious two course lunch, guide, private boat, coach transfer and entrance fees will be included.
