## 2027 Ski Bridge Holiday



### *4\* Seven Alpina Boutique Hotel*

*Saturday 6 – 13 March 2027*

We are delighted to make to return to the Seven Alpina Hotel in Klosters after the great snow and sunny conditions we had in 2026.

Klosters ([www.klosters.ch](http://www.klosters.ch)) is a captivating and welcoming mountain village, well linked to Davos and with extensive skiing (320km of pistes) right on the doorstep and just a three minute walk from our hotel. **The summit of Klosters/Davos is 2845m so higher than most resorts.**

The well-preserved village, the refined ambience and the hearty welcome extended by the locals all combine to make visitors feel at home. Winter sports enthusiasts will find a broad range of activities, while those looking for more relaxing recreation can enjoy the scenic landscape during leisurely walks.

The hotel is centrally located just a 2 minute walk to the cable car, has a charming bridge room and superb spa facilities including an indoor swimming pool. The hotel is rated "very good" on Trip Advisor.

Jack Stocken with co-host Grazyna Wrobel from ARBC will be hosting an informative and entertaining Bridge programme - the bridge standard is friendly improver/intermediate and no partner necessary. Jack will be running all other aspects of the holiday including bookings. Please book early.

We have a wonderful team of ski leaders headed by Suzi McArthur and Paul Ubysz. The ski leaders are all current or ex Ski Club of Great Britain reps and bring all their charm and expertise to the slopes. We will aim to keep the ski group size to a maximum of eight (or nine). **To join our ski leaders, skiers need to be able to ski red runs competently in any conditions.** Non-skiers are most welcome – full details on page 2.

**Resort:**

The lift link to Davos and all the kilometres of trails in between ensure that visitors have a truly world class winter sports arena to enjoy, and unlike many big areas, there are challenges for all ability levels here, not just endless intermediate level terrain. Klosters has two sectors known as Klosters Platz and Klosters Dorf. Platz is by far the more lively, and centre for most of the hotels, bars, restaurants and shops as well as the cable car link towards Davos. The Hotel Alpina is located in Klosters Platz.

**Skiing:**

The main reason to come to either Klosters or Davos is for the outstanding skiing. Although both resorts are quite far apart, they share the same ski area and lift pass – indeed, the prime attraction of skiing here is the sense of openness you get from cruising down broad well-tended pistes which go on and on, for more than 10km in many cases from mountaintop to valley bottom.

The big focus of everyone's attention is the **Parsenn** ski area on the West side of Klosters, with the Weissfluh summit as its centrepiece. It is accessed from the Gotschnagratt cable-car, just next to the Hotel Alpina, which rises from Klosters-Platz station to a ridge just east of the Weissfluh. Once you've arrived on the mountain, there are plenty of lifts serving dozens of blue and red runs, including giant, weaving pistes from the top of the Weissfluh all the way down through the trees to hamlets such as Küblis, Saas and Serneus, north of Klosters.

There are three other ski sectors in the Davos/Klosters area... from Davos Platz station, cable-cars rise to Ischalp, and from there to the **Jakobshorn** summit with a large selection of scenic blues and reds.

**Non-skiers:**

There is also plenty to do for non-skiers: cross country skiing and snowshoeing to take in the beautiful scenery, dogsledding, tobogganing and ice-skating to name but a few. Non-skiers now get a £75 discount off the price. **Last year there were eight non-skiers, so we laid on three extra afternoon bridge sessions for them!** There is no discount for non-bridge players.

**Ski Leaders:** We are delighted to have the services of our five ski leaders to cater for different ski standards. Suzi and Paul will be joined by Woody, Sophia and Clare to lead you round the mountains and find the best places for lunch!

To join our leaders, skiers should be able to ski red runs competently in any conditions; our ski leaders reserve the right to swap people between groups and if necessary, tell a skier that they must make their own arrangements with ski school at their own expense.

**Bridge:** The Bridge programme will follow its regular format, namely a pre-dinner tuition session with Andrew Robson's set hands, 5.15pm – 6.45pm, and after dinner, gentle duplicate, 8.30pm – 10.30pm, aimed at the improver/intermediate player. Alternatively, there is a supervised play session after dinner for the less experienced, known as "bar bridge!"

The Bridge is not suitable for players that are used to a serious 24 board club duplicate although we do have duplicate player on the trip. For further information please contact Jack.

**Hotel:** The Seven Hotel Alpina is a first-class hotel in a prime position in the centre of Klosters. It provides guests with impeccable hospitality in a refined but cosy atmosphere. Website: <https://seven.ch/hotels-and-apartments/alpina>

The hotel is rated very good on Trip Advisor and this was one of many excellent reviews:

The bedrooms are very comfortable and many of them have been refurbished in a very light modern style (please see below for more details). The bar is adjacent to the lobby and is very much a focal point after skiing and in the evenings, with live piano music. Breakfast is eaten in the light and airy Winter Garden restaurant, situated next to the Stübli room which is where we shall be playing Bridge from 5.30pm onwards.

There is a daily breakfast buffet (7am – 10am) and a welcome drink for our group on the first evening in the bar.

**Wellness:** "Wellness" facilities include a sauna, steam bath, solarium, swimming pool, beauty centre, massage and fitness corner. The Beauty Centre Alpina offers a large variety of treatments using excellent products.



**Bedrooms:** All bedrooms have balconies and are non-smoking. They feature a safe, telephone, Wi-Fi, wardrobe, desk and cosmetic products. As always, all rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first served basis” and rooming allocations are ultimately made at the hotel’s discretion.

All bedrooms are equipped with a non-separable double bed. In the Superior Rooms the hotel can add easily an extra bed without affecting the layout and the space of the room. In some standard double rooms, the hotel can still add an extra bed but this can limit the space of the room a little bit.

Bedrooms are walk-in shower only apart from Junior Suites which have shower over baths.

**Double Room:** 22 m2 with en-suite bathroom, walk-in shower only. Suitable for single occupants

**Superior Room:** 26 m2 with en-suite bathroom, walk-in shower only. Suitable for single occupants or two sharing

**Junior Suite:** 40 m2 with en-suite bathroom, and shower over bath. The bedroom has a sitting area and sofa bed. These rooms are for two sharing

## **Transport, Prices and Booking Conditions**

### **Booking:**

Bookings will not be confirmed or accepted without a non-refundable deposit and completed online booking form. Please book early so that we can try to accommodate any requests you may have. There is a £25 per person admin charge for any amendments to bookings which includes room upgrades.

### **Travel:**

**You will need to book your own flights** but if you book the British Airways flights below then you can join our coach transfer to/from the hotel (about two hours) for a small additional cost.

Or you could book different flights and join our coach transfers if your flights arrived before 12.30pm on 6 March. The coach cannot wait for any delays to different flights and guests would have to make their own way to the hotel at their own cost.

### **Money:**

- Should the £ fall by more than 5% against the Swiss Franc before 24 November 2026, a surcharge appropriate to the fall will be charged to all clients.
- The deposit is non-refundable
- Non-skiers receive a £75 discount
- The full balance is payable **no later** than 24 November 2026 (we will email a reminder).

### **Insurance:**

Everyone must have adequate travel insurance, to **include winter sports** if necessary. On booking, a signature will be required to guarantee that you have, or will have, made the necessary arrangements to insure your party as necessary.

### **Lift Pass:**

In 2026 the six-day pass cost SFR 386 (£355). This price is subject to a rise in 2027 and also subject to change depending on the exchange rate and the new rates for 2027. There is a 10% discount for seniors, over 64.

### **Luggage:**

Please ensure that all luggage is clearly labelled so that porters can deliver them directly to the bedrooms.

### **Ski Hire:**

We will be using Bardil Sports (2 minute walk from the hotel) and you will get a 15% group discount.

### **Cancellation:**

The deposit is non-refundable and once the balance has been paid, no refunds can be given but you can claim on your insurance.

ARB Holidays are not responsible for independent flights so if you cancel the holiday then you would need to claim a refund/voucher from your airline or claim on insurance.
