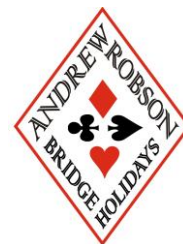


Andalusia, Spain 2027

ARBH are delighted to visit Andalusia for the first time for our summer bridge holiday, staying on the beautiful southern coast. With its whitewashed villages, historic towns, dramatic mountain landscapes and wonderfully relaxed way of life, this corner of Spain offers the perfect combination of culture, sunshine and excellent food.

Our home for the week will be the luxurious 5* OKU Andalusia, a stylish beachfront retreat close to Sotogrande. Set where the rolling Andalusian hills meet the Mediterranean, the hotel enjoys far-reaching views across the water towards the coast of Africa. Its relaxed, natural design, excellent restaurants and extensive leisure facilities make it an ideal setting in which to unwind and enjoy the warmth of southern Spain. There will be an interesting full day excursion visiting Ronda.

Bridge: Jack Stocken will be hosting an informative and entertaining Bridge programme which will include Andrew Robson's Lessons on five mornings (with set hands), Gentle Duplicate before dinner and relaxed supervised play after dinner. The standard is friendly improver/intermediate; the Bridge is not suitable for players that are used to a serious, competitive 24 board club duplicate.

Andalusia: Andalusia is Spain at its most colourful and atmospheric: a region of Moorish palaces, hilltop villages, flamenco traditions and long stretches of Mediterranean coastline. Its history has been shaped by many different cultures, leaving behind magnificent architecture, lively local customs and a distinctive cuisine.

OKU Andalusia is situated in the coastal village of La Alcaidesa, between Sotogrande and Gibraltar. The surrounding area is known for its beautiful beaches, prestigious golf courses and access to the wild landscapes of Los Alcornocales Natural Park. Gibraltar Airport is approximately 25 minutes away, while Málaga and Jerez airports are each around one hour and fifteen minutes by road.



5* Hotel OKU Andalusia: Located directly beside Playa de La Alcaidesa, OKU Andalusia brings the hotel group's signature laid-back style to the Costa del Sol. Interiors use natural materials, earthy colours and contemporary design to create a calm and informal atmosphere throughout the resort.

Guests can spend their days relaxing beside one of the pools, enjoying the beach, visiting the spa or simply finding a quiet corner from which to admire the sea views. Leisure facilities: The hotel has several outdoor swimming pools, direct access to the beach and a selection of peaceful terraces and relaxation areas. The impressive 2,000-square-metre OKU Spa includes an indoor swimming pool, steam room, sauna, relaxation room, treatment rooms and a modern fitness studio. A programme of wellness activities and restorative treatments will also be available. Spa treatments should be booked in advance to avoid disappointment.

Golf: This part of southern Spain is renowned for its golf, with a number of excellent courses around Sotogrande and the surrounding coastline. I will be on for a round or two so bring your golf shoes if you would like to join me!

Tennis: the hotel has three premium tennis courts and two padel courts so I will organise some casual, fun tennis/padel and find you a partner for some doubles.



Bedrooms: Rooms are equipped with balconies, walk-in showers, air conditioning, television, minibar, safe, coffee machine and Wi-Fi. The link to the hotel's website <https://www.okuhotels.com/oku-andalusia/rooms/>

Garden room: These rooms offer calm simplicity, featuring natural textures and muted tones with luxurious details. The open-plan space includes a king-size bed and en-suite with rainforest shower. Large sliding doors open onto your balcony allowing you to soak in views across lush hotel gardens.

Sea View room: The open-plan space includes a king-size bed and en-suite with rainforest shower. Large sliding doors open onto your balcony allowing you to have scenic views across the Mediterranean sea.

Deluxe Suite: Spacious Deluxe Suites offer room to spread out; these suites feature a large living area with full bar and en-suite bedroom with walk-in dressing room and extend out to a panoramic balcony with views over the Mediterranean sea.



Dining: We will dine in several different hotel restaurants during the course of our stay. Experience the sublime freshness and the taste of local ingredients. Discover age-old recipes reimagined for the modern connoisseur.

Ronda & the Olive Groves of Andalucía

A day trip that captures two of the most beloved sides of Andalucía: one of its most spectacular hilltop towns, and the ancient craft of olive oil that has shaped the region for centuries.

Your private bus picks you up at 9am from OKU Andalusia for the drive to Ronda, where you'll meet your local guide. Ronda is a must-see at any time of year. Split in two by the dramatic gorge of the Tajo river, with centuries-old Moorish houses clinging to the cliff tops and labyrinthine streets weaving through the old town, its views over the valley are extraordinary, and the three bridges spanning the canyon are engineering marvels in their own right.

Your guide walks you through the town's most iconic sites, from the Puente Nuevo and one of Spain's oldest bullrings to Don Bosco's house, along with a few lesser-known corners that are no less striking. History, drama, and the reason artists have been drawn to Ronda for centuries.

From there, into the countryside. A visit to a traditional almazara, or olive oil mill, where centuries of craftsmanship meet the quiet beauty of the Andalusian landscape. A guided tour of the estate's olive groves and historic mill is followed by a visit to the on-site museum that traces the heritage and evolution of olive oil production. A professional tasting introduces you to the nuances of premium extra virgin oils, an art deeply rooted in Andalusian culture.

The day closes with a picnic-style lunch served outdoors in a serene natural setting. Fresh, seasonal produce, local delicacies, and, of course, the estate's own olive oil throughout the meal.

Price to be confirmed in June 2027. Lunch, guide, coach transfer and entrance fees included.

Booking & Deposit:

Note that bookings will not be confirmed or accepted without a booking form and non-refundable deposit of £250. Please book early so that we can try to accommodate any requests you may have. Booking forms online on our website www.andrewrobsonbridgeholidays.co.uk

There is a £25 per person admin charge for any amendments to bookings which includes room upgrades. We do not accept cheques or debit/credit cards - best to pay via online banking.

Transport:

You will need to book your own flights but if you book the BA flights below then you can join our coach transfer to/from the hotel for a small additional cost. **These BA flights are not available yet but we will email you when they become available in early October 2026.**

The flight times are the same for the second week of 25 September. Transfer time to the hotel 25 minutes. EasyJet and other airlines will fly to Gibraltar. Best to book flights early as prices go up over time.

BA also have more regular flights from Heathrow and Gatwick to Malaga - transfer time to the hotel 1 hour 15 minutes.

- Bridge tuition to include 5 x lessons with Andrew's set hands, 6 x Gentle Duplicates and Supervised play after dinner (Chicago scoring)
- Exclusive use of the Bridge room for the week
- Welcome drink in the hotel before dinner on the first evening

The deposit is non-refundable and once the balance has been paid, no refunds will be given, although you should be able to claim on your insurance.

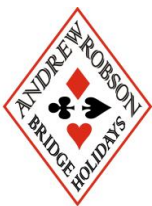
